Places per year	Places in compulsory courses are usually available. Places in block practicals and optional courses are limited. Placements (clinical electives) are arranged individually.

Restrictions	Students in their 5 th semester and above accepted. Prerequisites for individual courses are listed in our course catalogue.
Language requirements	German for compulsory courses: B1 recommended B1/B2 required for Pharmacology, Toxicology and Neurology Physical Examination courses; places in Pharmacology, Toxicology course confirmed only after a personal conversation with the instructor C1 required for Psychiatry and Psychotherapy, and Psychosomatic Medicine B2 required for additional clinical rotations (at start of placement) German for clinical placements: B2 required mandatory B2 level at start of placement, i.e. it is possible to apply with, for example, a B1 certificate and a proof of attendance of a B2 level course C1 required for Emergency Medicine (practical year only), Psychiatry and Psychotherapy, and Psychosomatic Medicine Read a detailed description of Common European Framework of Reference for
